
Dear Mr. Haddock:

Enclosed are 14 copies of Pages 3-36, 3-36(a), 3-38(a), and 3-39 to amend our approved M&RP.

This amendment clarifies the use of side covers along the overland conveyor. We find that as we approach the operational phase of the overland conveyor, we need to leave some of the covers off to provide for adequate inspection and maintenance of the conveyor system. Normally we will leave the covers off the uphill side of the conveyor, so as to maintain the visual aesthetics from the state highway. Since the coal is fully enclosed in the conveyor tube, we are still exceeding the air quality permit requirements.
