Attached is a drawing of the minimum dimensions of Berm B-1. As you will note there is a negative grade on both sides of the Berm so there should be no depth of water controlled by this Berm.

Map No. 3.2.1-3 has been clarified to show the location of culvert CD-13 ditch DD-9 and surrounding contours. The slope of the ditch DD-9 going into and leaving CD-13 is approximately 4.5%. With this slope, only inlet control has been provided. We would like approval for this culvert to be 60' long rather than 40' long.

One copy of Map 3.2.1-3, outlet control for CD-13 and minimum dimension of Berm B-1 have been attached. If this information is adequate, contact Keith Zobell and he will provide you with additional copies for our approval distribution.
