**RE: ABATEMENT OF NOV93-39-5-3 (1 OF 3), PERMIT AMENDMENT**

Attached are DOGM Forms C1 and C2, along with the necessary documents to amend Skyline's permit to satisfy part A of NOV93-39-5-3 (1 of 3).

We recognize that we haven't yet demonstrated to the Division that siltation structures and alternate sediment control measures are not necessary for drainage from the disturbed areas to meet the effluent limitations for the South Fork of Eccles Creek exempt areas.

We have collected the necessary soil samples, and are sending them to the laboratory, so we can obtain the necessary data to run the Sed-Cad program.

Due to the time limitation on the NOV, we didn't feel we would wait until these results are obtained to submit this amendment required by the NOV. As soon as the soils data is received, and we have run the program, we will submit the results.

We do not plan on running the Sed-Cad program for the overland conveyor bench exempt areas.

The exempt areas along the overland conveyor are small disturbed areas where the topsoil and subsoil were removed the resulting holes filled with concrete. This results in the disturbed areas being totally protected by concrete covered by overland conveyor gallery. There is no source for silt from our disturbance. We feel the demonstration is obvious.
