

As you should already be aware, OSM issued Ten-Day Notice #93-02-116-001 to the Division contending that Coastal had not fully disclosed information showing ownership and control links to Virginia Iron Coal and Coke. Although the links have now been established, there are additional questions regarding the adequacy of the legal financial section of Skyline's Mining and Reclamation Plan. A Division order is enclosed which requires Coastal to provide the missing information. One of the main concerns centers around differences noted between Skyline' and Sufco's legal financial sections. Information for all four of Coastal's Utah operations should correlate.

ORDER & FINDINGS

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PURSUANT to R645-303-212, the DIVISION ORDERS the PERMITTEE, Coastal States Energy Company, to make the permit changes enumerated in the findings of permit deficiency in order to be in compliance with the State Coal Program. 
Requirements
