



Re: *Approval of Waste Rock Expansion*

Gentlemen:

Enclosed are 12 copies of the plans for the expansion of the Waste Rock Disposal site at Scofield.

We have also enclosed 14 copies of the following responses to the conditions for the approval of the Waste Rock Expansion.

Conditions:

- Coastal must amend the Mining and Reclamation Plan to state the woody plant density standard for success and to include provisions to monitor woody plant species after the first 40% of the extended responsibility period.*

Response:

We have changed Page 4-46 to indicate the standard for success. Page 4-46 already includes provisions to monitor woody plant species after the first 40% of the extended responsibility period.

- Coastal must amend the Mining and Reclamation plan to contain provisions to monitor raptor nests for nesting success within 1/2 mile radius of the Waste Rock site.*

Response:

We have changed Pages 4-103a and 4-103b to meet this condition. This requirement was coordinated with Bill Bates of DWR.
