

*Re: Deficiencies in Plan to Construct Portals in Lower O'Connor Coal Seam*


*Gentlemen:*

*We have enclosed a copy of our blasting plan for this project. Other than our own facilities, there are no other dwellings or structures within 1/2 mile of the site. Therefore, no preblast survey is needed.*

*We have included the abandoned mine openings on Map 3.2.1-1. We have also included a certified copy of figure 2.12-B which shows the underground workings of the abandoned Eccles Canyon Mine. These workings are indicated to the best of our knowledge.*

*The potential subsidence of SR 264 is covered in our approved plan in an agreement with UDOT. The proposed portals will be approximately 40 ft. beneath SR 264. The roof will be roof bolted and additional steel support will be installed beneath SR 264. At the conclusion of mining operations, the area beneath SR 264 will be backfilled.*
