





Dear Sirs:

Re: Permit Change For Portals For Lower O'Connor "B" Coal Seam

Enclosed are DOGM Forms C-1 and C-2 for a permit change to construct the necessary surface portals to access the Lower O'Connor "B" Coal Seam.

One of the portals will be a rock slope and will have a coal conveyor to move coal from the Lower O'Connor "B" Seam to the surface. This conveyor (BC-2) will eliminate the current need to construct the BC-5 conveyor, for which we recently received permit approval. Please cancel our request ACT/007/005-94B Folder #3 for the BC-5 Conveyor.

Two of the portals will be on the lower pad level near the sedimentation pond. In order to improve the drainage maintenance in the vicinity of these portals, we are proposing to lengthen and enlarge the culvert CD-2. We plan on enlarging the culvert to 48 inches to allow sufficient room for personnel to clean the culvert. No additional water will be going through it. No other drainage patterns will be affected by the proposed change.

We have also enclosed new pages for the bonding calculations. We still have excess bonding available.
