Attached are forms C1 and C2 for a permit change which will change conveyor BC-5 from future to existing.


Conveyor BC-5 was envisioned and contemplated when the stacking tube system was permitted and was included on permitting at that time. We are now going to construct BC-5 which will enhance our coal handling capabilities. There will only be minor surface disturbance at bent leg locations within the already existing disturbed area. There will be no affect on the existing surface drainage system.

The main effect of this change will be on the reclamation bond. We have enclosed pages for the reclamation bond. On Page 4 - 16 we have changed the number of conveyors from 7 to 8 which increases the required bonding to cover this new facility. We still have adequate bonding to cover this increase.
