4a. Diversions -

The diversions throughout the property were clear of sediment and were not passing water during the inspection. There were no signs of erosion or breaching of these ditches.

4b. Sediment Ponds -

The sediment ponds on the site showed no signs of erosion or embankment failure. The pond at the main mining complex has been in compliance with the Department of Water Quality standards.

4c. Other Sediment Control Measures -

Skyline has installed sediment control measures for the conveyor bench to the loadout facility as required in the approved amendment. The Notice of Violation for these areas have been terminated. Other ASCA areas will be under review for adequate designs.
