Dear Mr. Payne:

The Division has completed a review of your responses to conditions placed on the June 21, 1993 partial approval of your Loadout Expansion Project. It is determined that the conditions have been adequately addressed. The plans are now considered to be complete and adequate for approval and insertion to your Mining and Reclamation Plan.

The Division hereby issues final approval of the above referenced amendment. There are some issues that require further clarification which can be provided with copies that will be submitted for distribution. These issues deal with Drawing No. 3.2.1-4 'Railroad Loadout Sediment Pond'. On this map the 7920 contour lines are extremely faint. Better copies will need to be made. Also, the map must show the minimum embankment height so that it is clear that adequate freeboard is maintained between the overflow and the top of the embankment. Coastal must submit 12 copies of the complete amendment including corrections to 3.2.1-4 drawing by no later than April 25, 1994.
