The Division has completed a review of your plans and designs received February 18, 1994 proposing to add additional Surface Facilities to the Skyline Mine. The plans are considered to be complete and adequate for approval and insertion to your Mining and Reclamation Plan.

The Division hereby approves the above referenced amendment with the following conditions: 1) Coastal must provide information that shows that the design peak flows for the existing diversions can safely pass through the inlets and outlets of the sediment traps; 2) Coastal must provide labels for the sediment box designs which match the corresponding structure on the map so that it is clear which design goes with which structure; 3) Coastal must submit 12 copies of the complete amendment by no later than April 18, 1994 for distribution to other agencies. Information under #1 and #2 above should be incorporated into the copies.
