The Division has completed a review of your submittal received on November 1, 1993 which proposes adding sediment storage traps and a rock storage area to the Skyline Mine facilities. The proposed changes cannot be approved at this time due to the following deficiencies.

- 1) Sediment Traps 1 and 2 have no design included to demonstrate the traps allow the design flow to pass without affecting the existing drainage channel. Traps 3 and 4 have no designed outlets.
- 2) No details for cleanout of the sedimentation traps have been provided.
- 3) Design details for the 15" culvert at the north side of the Sediment Pond have not been provided (includes inlet and outlet elevations).

In order to implement the proposed surface facilities, the above deficiencies will need to be addressed. Please provide a response no later than February 22, 1994. If you have any questions regarding the deficiencies, please contact Sharon Falvey, Senior Reclamation Hydrologist.
