


Dear Mr. Demczak:

During the month of November 1995 a metal enclosure was constructed around the overland conveyor dust collector system. The location of this enclosure is shown on Map 3.2.1-3. The amount of additional bonding required as a result of the construction of this enclosure was submitted to the Division and approved on September 7, 1995. However, we failed to obtain specific approval from the Division to actually install this enclosure. This failure resulted in the above referenced violation.

In order to abate this violation and obtain Division approval for this change to our facility we have revised page 3-38(a) for replacement in the Skyline Permit. The required 14 copies of this page are enclosed for your review.


