

As a result of discussions held at the Skyline Mine on August 22, 1995, with representatives of the Division we are submitting 14 copies of the following to complete our response to the above referenced Mid-Term Review:

- Page 3-45 of the Skyline permit has been revised to include a statement that runoff from stream buffer zone areas reports to sedimentation ponds, is treated by alternate sediment control, or the areas are demonstrated to be exempt. This statement also included a reference to page 3-64 which is the beginning of the permit discussion of alternate sediment control areas and exempt areas.
- Page 16 of Part 5 has been revised to include a cross reference from R645-301-731.611 to page 3-64 of the permit.

It is our understanding that by replacing these pages in the Skyline permit the permit changes required by the Mid-Term Review are essentially complete. However, assignments were made during the August 22 meeting relating to other concerns expressed in the original Mid-Term Review. These assignments are as follows:

- Paul Baker and Keith Zobell will select a vegetation reference area for the steep cut slopes along the over-land conveyor.
- Wayne Western is to examine Approximate Original Contour criteria and determine how these criteria, along with the possible use of cross-sections, can be used to show that the reclamation plan for the Skyline Mine will return the site to AOC.
