4a. DIVERSIONS -

The diversions were functioning as designed. The temperature was warm enough to start snow melt. The water was contained within the disturbed area by the diversions.

4b. SEDIMENT PONDS -

The railroad sediment ponds contained water and may discharge in the near future. This would be the first time in several years. The mine site pond was discharging as always. No problems were noted with the embankment of these ponds. The waste rock pond was still inaccessible due to snow on the ground.

4c. OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES -

Several ASCA areas were inspected with all functioning as designed. Some of the areas will need maintenance to the structures due to the heavy snowfalls this year. Operator will fix the fences.
