**1. PERMIT -**

- a) The insurance is with Flat Top Insurance Company. This policy will expire on March 15, 1995. The insurance policy meets the requirements of the R645 regulations.
- b) The operator has sent letters to the landowner stating mining is taking place on their ground and a subsidence plan is in the MRP at the court house and the division field office in Price.
- c) The sediment ponds were inspected for fourth quarter with no hazardous conditions existing. The annual ponds inspection for the gob pond was taken Nov. 1, 1994.
- d) The refuse pile was P.E. certified for fourth quarter with no hazardous conditions existing.
- e) The surface facility map was updated and approved by the division.
- d) The MRP is under mid-term review by the division, and the operator is waiting for response.
- e) The operator has a new Spill Prevention Plan as of March 6, 1995. The new plan is P.E. certified.
- f) The subsidence plans for 1994 was reviewed with no problems noted. This years plan is being completed and will be submitted in the Annual Report.

**4a. DIVERSIONS -**

The diversions were inspected and were functioning as designed. The water was flowing into the ponds as required in the MRP.

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**b. SEDIMENT PONDS -**

The sediment pond at the mine site and railroad loadout was inspected with no hazardous conditions noticed. The embankments were covered with snow. The mine site pond was discharging and the rail pond was two feet from discharging out of the spillway.

The refuse pond was inaccessible due to snow cover.

**7. REFUSE PILE -**

The refuse pile was not accessible due to snow cover.
