1. PERMIT -

- a) Insurance was reviewed with the expiration date of 3/15/95. The insurance is through Flat Top Insurance Co. All requirements of the R645 regulations were met.
- b) The operator has copies of letters to landowners dealing with subsidence and notification of mining.
- c) The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining is in the process of mid-term review of Skyline permit.
- d) The SPCC Plan is being reviewed by P.E.

4a. DIVERSIONS -

The diversions were spot-checked with water flowing to the sediment ponds. Several ditches were recently cleaned out.

b. SEDIMENT PONDS -

The mine pond was discharging during the inspection. The railroad loadout was not discharging. The refuse pond was inaccessible to inspection due to 30 inches of snow.
