Re: Notice of Closing

Dear Daron:

The purpose this letter is to request that you effect the transfer of the following: (1) Permit ACT/007/005, Skyline Mine; (2) Permit ACT/041/002, SUFCo Mine; (3) Permit ACT/007/018, Soldier Canyon Mine; (4) Permit ACT/007/034, Banning Loadout; and (5) the permit application for the Dugout Mine (permit pending). As you know, Canyon Fuel Company, LLC has submitted transfer applications to the Utah Division of Oil Gas and Mining ("DOGM") for all of these coal mining operations in anticipation of closing the merger and purchase transaction between The Coastal Corporation, Coastal Coal Company, Atlantic Richfield Company, and Itochu Corporation described more fully in the transfer applications themselves. We also submitted riders making Canyon Fuel Company, LLC the principal on the reclamation bonds presently held by DOGM for the above-referenced permits. We requested that DOGM hold the Reclamation Agreements and the riders, leaving the current agreements and bonds in place without amendment, until DOGM received official notice of the closing.

In correspondence dated, December 19, 1996, DOGM issued written approval of the transfers contingent upon closing of the merger and purchase transaction. Please be advised that the anticipated closing has occurred: (1) Soldier Creek Coal Company has merged into Sage Point Coal Company; (2) Sage Point Coal Company, Southern Utah Fuel Company, Skyline Coal Company, and Utah Fuel Company have all merged into Coastal States Energy Company ("CSEC"); (3) CSEC has merged into

Canyon Fuel Company, LLC; and (4) ARCO Uinta Coal Company and Itochu Coal International, Inc. have purchased Canyon Fuel Company.

Canyon Fuel Company is now successor to all of the interests of these other entities, including their Utah coal mining interests. Consequently, the final condition for transfer of the permits has been satisfied. Please place into effect Canyon Fuel Company's Reclamation Agreements for the above referenced mining operations, including the riders substituting Canyon Fuel Company, LLC as the principal on the reclamation bonds.
