

TOPIC ENGINEERING

ANALYSIS

- 1) The permittee has submitted and met all the necessary requirements for adding to the existing storage shed. The addition is a 10 feet by 12 feet building.
- 2) The addition is within the existing disturbed area. This area presently reports to a sediment pond at the railroad loadout.
- 3) This area is not within the U.S. Forest Service area and will not affect the public lands.
- 4) The Surface Facility Map has been updated and is P.E. certified.
- 5) The permittee has received a Building Permit from the county.
- 6) The TA should not be modified for this amendment.



FINDINGS

- 1) Amendment ACT/007/005-96D has an updated surface facility map giving the location of the storage building. This meets the R645-512 for a certified map. The permittee has followed all regulations of other State, Federal and local agencies.
