ORDINANCE 1998-1

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SPECIFIC SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE 1987-3, 1990-1
 AND 1991-1 OF THE PRICE RIVER WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Price River Water Improvement District (District) have
 determined that increases of certain fees has become necessary and would be in the best interest
