Analysis:

Development waste is an integral part of the mine process. The permittee presently has permission to store and slurry underground development waste into underground workings. It was approved by the Division, US Forest Service and MSHA.



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Findings:

- R645-301-512.** The surface facilities map has been updated and certified.
- R645-301-528.350** The permittee has complied with the necessary information, since these are the same requirements as the underground slurry system of storing underground waste.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended for approval, but needs USFS consent.
