Aspen Products Pipeline LLC and Questar Pipeline Company have applied for Right-of-Way grants for the proposed Aspen Pipeline Project and the proposed Main Line 40/41 Loop Pipeline, respectively, from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and United States Forest Service (USFS). The BLM and USFS will be hosting public scoping meetings to gather public input on this application. The proposed Aspen Pipeline Project will transport a variety of petroleum products to New Mexico, western Colorado, and the Wasatch Front area of Utah using a network of existing and proposed new underground pipelines. The proposed Main Line 40/41 Loop Pipeline is put forward to service the current and future need to supply additional capacity for natural gas developed south of Price, Utah, to be transported to markets along the Wasatch Front and those supplied by the existing Kern River Pipeline. Under separate application, Questar Pipeline Company is proposing to replace approximately 5 miles of its existing 18 inch Mainline 41 pipeline due to underground mining operations. The proposed reroute is located within the Manti la Sal National Forest. This project will also be analyzed in the EIS. In Colorado, these proposed projects will occur in Dolores, La Plata, Montezuma and San Miguel Counties. In Utah, they will occur in Grand, Emery, Sanpete, Utah, and Salt Lake Counties. The attached map depicts the location of the proposed projects.


