SUMMARY:

The permittee would like to install a temporary diversion (6 inch pipe) at the waste rock site. The function of the diversion is to divert undisturbed drainage away from the disturbed area. This is in lieu of having the undisturbed drainage pass through the disturbed area and being treated by straw bales.
