NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR COMMENT PARSHALL FLUME PLACEMENT, SKYLINE MINE

The Manti-La Sal National Forest is evaluating a request from Canyon Fuel Company to install two Parshall flumes for the purpose of water monitoring, one each in Swens Canyon and Little Swens Canyon creeks at their confluences with Huntington Creek. The area of the proposal lies on National Forest System lands administered by the Manti-La Sal National Forest, Ferron-Price Ranger District. The proposal involves installing one Parshall flume in the stream channel at each site. Each flume is approximately 5 feet long by 2.5 feet wide. The stream flow is directed through the flume, which is calibrated to show the volume of the stream flow. The flume will be used to monitor variations in stream flow. No water will be used, depleted, or diverted. The environmental effects of this proposal are expected to be negligible. Because only negligible impacts are expected, and there are no extraordinary circumstances, it is proposed to categorically exclude this project from preparation of an environmental impact statement or an environmental assessment.

Comments are invited on this proposal.
