Your application to capture the spring at or near the coal stock pile and add two sediment traps to the surface facility area has been reviewed by Senior Reclamation Specialist Mike Suflita. Some additional information must be supplied before we can approve your application. This is outlined below.

- You must provide plans to filter out coal fines from entering the spring diversion and to trap any possible coal fines prior to their entering the spring system.
- You must provide a means to allow for inspection of your spring diversion assembly.
- You must clearly indicate on the drawings how water will enter and exit the proposed sediment basins.

A copy of Mike's technical analysis is enclosed to provide more detail and aid you in responding to the deficiencies. In order for us to keep this in our review loop, please provide your response by no later than September 1, 1999.
