An extension was granted until 22 June 2000, for submitting the reclaim slope configuration using a concave slope. Mr. Mike Suflita reviewed the concave slope plan during his inspection at the mine site on 21 June 2000. He felt we were progressing in a manner with the concave slopes that would greatly increase the reclaim slope stability and at the same time reduce erosion of the soils. He asked at the time of the inspection that slope stability analysis be performed on the slope. We have not been able to find a stability program at the present time. We are requesting an extension to 25 July 2000, to allow us to find a program and complete the slope analysis.
