Manti-La Sal National Forest

The Forest Service (FS) and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) are proposing to offer the Flat Canyon Coal Lease Tract (UTU-77114) for competitive leasing after receiving an application for leasing the tract from Canyon Fuel Company, LLC. The agencies will jointly prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to evaluate the tract and disclose the environmental and human effects. The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSM) will participate as a cooperating agency.

The agencies invite written comments and suggestions on the issues related to the proposed action and the area being analyzed. Information received will be used to identify issues and reasonable alternatives to be analyzed, prepare the Draft and Final EIS, and make the respective agency decisions.

The coal lease tract to be considered for leasing, as delineated by the Interagency Tract Delineation Team, encompasses 2,692.16 acres of Federal coal lands on the Manti-La Sal National Forest as follows:

- T. 13S., R. 6E., SLM
- Section 21, lots 1-4, E1/2E1/2;
- Section 28, lots 1-8, S1/2NW1/4, SW1/4;
- Section 33, E1/2, E1/2W1/2, NW1/4/NW1/4, SW1/4SW1/4.

- T. 14S., R. 6E, SLM
- Section 4, lots 1-4, S1/2N1/2, S1/2;
- Section 5, lots 1-4, S1/2N1/2, S1/2.

If the tract is leased and Canyon Fuel is successful in obtaining it, they intend to extend the existing underground workings of the Skyline Mine to the west into the Flat Canyon Tract to extend the mine life an estimated 7-9 years at the current production rate.

The Forest Service determined that the proposed lands are available for further consideration for the coal leasing under the Land and Resource Management Plan (Forest Plan, Final EIS, and Record of Decision (ROD) for the Manti-La Sal National Forest, 1986.

The BLM Utah State Director must decide whether or not to offer the tract for competitive leasing and under what terms, conditions, and stipulations. The Forest Supervisor, Manti-La Sal National Forest must decide whether or not to consent to leasing by BLM and under what conditions for the protection of non-mineral resources.

Written comments concerning the scope of the analysis described in this notice should be received on or before April 18, 2000. Send written comments to Forest Supervisor, Manti-La Sal National Forest, 599 West Price River Drive, Price, Utah 84501. Comments received in response to this solicitation, including names and addresses, will be considered part of the public record and will be available for public inspection. Pursuant to 7 CFR 1.27(d), any person may request that a submission be withheld from the public record by showing how the Freedom of Information Act permits such confidentiality. Persons requesting such confidentiality should be aware that such confidentiality is granted in only very limited circumstances. The Forest will inform the requester of its decision regarding a request for confidentiality, and where the request is denied, the Forest will return the submission and notify the requester that the comments may be resubmitted with or without name and address.
