



The Manti-La Sal National Forest (FS) and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) are reviewing a proposal from Canyon Fuel Company, LLC to modify Federal Coal Lease U-044076 by adding 121.5 acres originally excluded when it was issued in 1965. The lease modification area lies in the Upper Huntington Creek area north of Electric Lake within the Manti-La Sal National Forest in Emery County, T.13 S., R. 6E., SLM. This area is completely encompassed by the existing lease and was excluded to protect the Bureau of Reclamation Lawrence Reservoir withdrawal. The withdrawal was revoked after construction of Electric Lake Dam and Reservoir.

The FS and BLM are proposing to add the former withdrawal area to the current lease and approve full-support mining to allow recovery of Federal coal reserves and increase recovery of coal in adjacent areas. The current lease is included in the permit area for the Skyline Mine and has been approved for mining.

Since no surface disturbance is expected and no extraordinary circumstances have been identified at this time, the project qualifies for categorical exclusion from preparation of an Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement Forest Service Handbook 1950.15, Section 31.1b, Item 7.

Pursuant to 7 CFR 1.27(d), any person may request that a submission be withheld from the public record by showing how the Freedom of Information Act permits such confidentiality. Persons requesting such confidentiality should be aware that such confidentiality is granted in only very limited circumstances. The Forest will inform the requester of its decision regarding request for confidentiality. If the request is denied, the Forest will return the submission and notify the requester that the comments may be resubmitted with or without name and address.
