Dear Daron:

As we discussed on the phone this morning, we have made some modifications to the text regarding the abandonment of equipment underground. As discussed, Skyline does not have hazardous materials associated with the mining equipment currently used at the mine. Lead-acid batteries are part of the diesel equipment used in the mine but batteries are not left underground. Therefore, I have removed the reference to hazardous materials and added "lubricating and hydraulic fluids are removed to the extent possible".

I have included with this letter eight clean copies of the modified text, including the copy for the Price Field Office, and four copies with strikethrough of removed text and new text denoted with bold italics.


