Chris,

This is to confirm our conversation of today. As I explained, DOGM has formed a Visualization Modeling Team. The purpose is to improve the maps used in our CHIAs and make the data more accessible to our reviewers when we work on projects. Several Geographic Information System (GIS) layers will also be used for presentations, such as at public meetings, to better show the situations to non-technical audiences. Due to the importance of the Skyline water issues, we're in the process of updating the Skyline/White Oak CHIA. Thus, we need the most current information.

To that end, will you please provide the Division with an electronic version of the following items listed below? All info needs to be in the **native format**, such as Autocad. That is, NOT in PDF format. For each map and figure please include any associated **Metadata**. The Metadata should at least include Scale, Data Source, and Date. The map files need to include the **projection type**, such as Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM) grid coordinates or State Plane Coordinates.

1. All maps, figures, plates, and cross-sections in the HCI Progress Report No. 2, dated February 2002.
2. Drawings Numbered PHC A-1, PHC A-2, PHC A-3, and PHC A-4, from the James Canyon/ PHC Amendment.
3. Drawings Numbered PHC A-1, PHC A-2, PHC A-3, and PHC A-4, from the North Lease (Winter Quarters) Extension amendment.

I realize that items 2 and 3 above may represent duplicate information. Just be sure the data completely covers the entire permit area and no information is omitted.

In our conversation you agreed to provide this information and we do thank you. As soon as you get the info, please forward it to us. Our base maps are already prepared and we're ready to include the requested material.
