The permit renewal was issued on April 30, 2002 with five conditions. This letter outlines the status of these conditions:

- 1) Canyon Fuel Company, LLC must submit water quality data for the Skyline Mine in an electronic format through the Electronic Data Input web site, <http://linux1.ogm.utah.gov/cgi-bin/appx-ogm.cgi>

This is an ongoing condition and requires Canyon Fuel Company, LLC submit water quality data for the Skyline Mine on a quarterly basis to the Division.

- 2) Within 45 days of permit renewal, Canyon Fuel Company, LLC must assemble, analyze and submit to the Division all existing studies and data for the update of the PHC as a result of the mine inflows. Further, CFC must continue to provide all data as required to comply with R645-301-728.

This is a condition that requires Canyon Fuel Company, LLC to assemble, analyze and submit all existing studies and data for the update of the PHC as a result of the mine inflows. The original date for the permit renewal was April 30, 2002, which would have required a submittal date of June 15, 2002. However, there was a meeting at the Division on May 8, 2002 at which the permit conditions were discussed. The permit was subsequently signed on May 16, 2002. Granting this as a built in extension, the 45 days from May 16, 2002 would be
