Dear Mr. Ward:

Enclosed is the information you requested at the March 16, 2004, meeting.

Drawing 2.3.6-1 encompasses all the water monitoring sites Canyon Fuel Company – Skyline Mine currently conducts, with the exception of a few sites located below the dam, on Finn Canyon, and Boardinghouse Canyon which will be added in the very near future.

I have also provided two (2) graphs outlining the mine discharges from Skyline Mine, as requested. The graph titled, “Skyline Mine Average Monthly Discharge” is somewhat easier to read, and includes the water being discharged to Electric Lake. Keep in mind that JC-1 is not considered a mine discharge because it is drawing water from below the mine.

The other graph, “Skyline Mine Contributions to Eccles Creek”, illustrates more variability because it represents ‘spot measurements’ instead of monthly averages. However, from 1995 to 1999, CS-2 closely illustrates the base flows of Eccles Creek prior to encountering the increased mine-inflows.


