Pam:

I have been able to complete the daily discharge numbers for the James Canyon wells for the month of October. However, once again, we are having issues getting the mine discharge flow data from the computer memory. We have averaged a discharge of about 3500 gpm of water from the mine to Eccles Creek through the month of October. However, this number is based only on occasional observations of the flow rate, not recorded data. Normally, we download our instantaneous readings that are taken once every 30 seconds and recorded in the mine Conspec system. I take the 30-second readings and create an average discharge rate over a 24 hour period. That 24-hour average is then reported on our spreadsheet. The person who is able to wrestle the data out of our Conspec system has been out of the office this week but will be in on Monday. One other employee is trusted with the keys to the Conspec system but has not yet been successful in getting the necessary data. If all else fails, I should have the mine discharge data available Monday. I alerted Gregg Galecki this morning that we were having trouble with the mine discharge data recovery.
