Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

Based on recent correspondence with Mr. Brent Stettler of the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources – Dedicated Hunter Program Coordinator, Southeast Region, Canyon Fuel Company, LLC Skyline Mines is requesting a review of wildlife enhancement projects to be conducted by volunteers from the Dedicated Hunter Program. Mr. Stettler indicated if the projects are not included in the M&RP as permit requirements, UDWR would approve the projects Skyline Mine has outlined. He suggested a DOGM biologist review the projects to confirm the projects are not an existing permit requirement. Proposed projects are as follows:

Weed Spraying – Skyline Mine is required to conduct weed control on specific portions of the permit area, however a more effective way to control the weeds on the permit area and be better stewards of the land is to do additional spraying. Skyline proposes Dedicated Hunter Volunteers conduct spraying outside the permit maintenance areas through Eccles Canyon, South Fork of Eccles Canyon and possibly areas in both Burnout and James Canyons.

Eccles Canyon Maintenance – Skyline Mine will provide tools, supplies, supervision and support for garbage pickup and general clean up along SR 264 and Eccles Creek in Eccles Canyon. Duties will include garbage pickup, partial removal of beaver dams for easier fish migration, and general maintenance.
