The 4th Qtr 2008 water monitoring data for Skyline is in the Pipeline and ready to be uploaded into the Database. To our knowledge, the only missing data / errors are listed below.

VC-6 The sample was initially collected on 12/31/2008, we were then notified that the Oil and Grease bottle was broken in transit to the lab. We re-sampled on 1/7/2008 after contacting Jim Smith. Both of the samples are in the pipeline but only the sample dated 12/31/2008 has all of the required data. The sample dated 1/7/2008 only has the Oil and Grease data.

92-91-03 This sample is in the pipeline but is asking for Dissolved Iron and Manganese which are not required parameters.

JC-1 The sample for the 3rd quarter is in the pipeline but is asking for Total Iron which is not required.

JC-1 Age Dating This sample requires Tritium.

2-413 This sample requires Tritium.

8-253 This sample requires Tritium.

EL-1 This sample requires Tritium.

EL-2 This sample requires Tritium.
