Please find enclosed with this letter Skyline Mine's application to identify the Ambulance shed on the Skyline Mine Surface Facility Map - Plate 3.2.1-1. This submittal includes eight (8) clean copies of Plate 3.2.1-1; Mine Surface Facilities Plot Plan.

During a routine site inspection by Inspector Karl Houskeeper, he observed a shed (previously located by the substation) had been moved, with a garage door being added to the shed. Mr. Houskeeper suggested we identify the new location on Plate 3.2.1-1. Because the shed is mobile (mounted on I-beams), and within the existing disturbed area he thought no additional bonding or internal review would be necessary.
