## **ADMINISTRATIVE OVERVIEW**

### **PROPOSAL**

Canyon Fuel Company, LLC made application to the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining for a five year permit renewal for the Skyline Mine on October 26, 2011. The renewed permit will be comprised of the same permit area and disturbed area as presently permitted.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) for the Skyline Mine was originally approved by the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) on June 20, 1980. The Permittee was Coastal States Energy Company and the Operator was Utah Fuel Company. On July 20, 1984 a revised permit was issued which authorized the use of a waste rock disposal site near the town of Scofield. On March 28, 1985 the Division of Oil Gas and Mining (DOG M) and OSM determined that the permit would expire on April 30, 1987 five years from the date of initial operations, and notified the Operator accordingly. The Permittee submitted a timely application for permit renewal in 1986.

Due to numerous problems in formatting and technical issues associated with the original MRP, the mine operated under short-term permits from April 30, 1987 to December 1, 1989 when a renewal was issued. That renewed permit was scheduled to expire on April 30, 1992, ten years from the date of initial operations. On December 31, 1991 Coastal States Energy Company submitted another application for permit renewal which included an updated Mining and Reclamation Plan formatted to the new R614 (R645) regulations. The renewed permit for an additional 5-year period until April 30, 1997 was conditioned upon satisfactorily complying with a Division Order that required additional PHC information. The permit was transferred from Coastal States Energy Company to Canyon Fuel Company, LLC on December 20, 1996. The permit was again renewed through April 30, 2002.

A 28-acre IBC on fee land was approved on August 25, 2000. A fee lease to increase the permit area by 459 acres was approved on April 24, 2001.

The permit was renewed on April 30, 2002 with four conditions relating to water discharge issues as well as the condition for submittal of water monitoring electronically.

The significant amounts of water encountered in the mine prompted the mining company to move their mining efforts toward the North Lease. In order to access the North Lease, the company applied for an 84-acre Incidental Boundary Change on a fee lease, which was approved on August 16, 2002.

Canyon Fuel Company, LLC, submitted the permit application package for adding the North Lease (Winter Quarters) Tract to the Skyline Mine on September 4, 2002. Development mining in the North Lease received mining plan approval on December 20, 2002. Full extraction for this area received mining plan approved on February 24, 2006. The Cumulative Hydrologic Impact Assessment (CHIA) for the Skyline Mine was updated with that permitting action. On April 30, 2007 the permit was again renewed for an additional five years.

The Skyline mine plan area (including the North Lease) incorporates federal coal leases and one Carbon County coal lease. The surface disturbed area includes disturbances (surface facilities) on Forest Service lands and private land (Unit Train Loadout and Waste Rock Disposal sites). The access to the Waste Rock Disposal Pit is a private road and is not scheduled for reclamation.

Canyon Fuel Company, LLC submitted an application to construct the Winter Quarters Ventilation Facility at the Skyline mine. This application was approved on July 29, 2010. A revised permit was issued to update the permit area and authorized mining area of the Skyline mine at the time of that permitting action. Because of a recent change in how the Division interprets the definition of permit area, Canyon Fuel Company also chose to revise its permit area during this action and the permit area now reflects the actual surface disturbed area, which is 12.97 acres. There are 11,943 acres in the authorized mining area. This is the same area that is now being proposed for renewal. The current permit expires on April 30, 2012.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

Canyon Fuel Company, LLC has demonstrated that mining of the Skyline Mine can be done in conformance with the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act and the corresponding Utah Act and performance standards. Approval for permit renewal is recommended with two conditions:

- 1) Canyon Fuel Company, LLC must submit water quality data for the Skyline Mine in an electronic format through the Electronic Data Input web site, <http://linux1.ogm.utah.gov/cgi-bin/appx-ogm.cgi>
- 2) Canyon Fuel Company, LLC must submit cumulative monthly flow data for discharges into Electric Lake and Eccles Creek. This monthly data must be submitted in the first week of the following month.



April 4, 2012	The Division approves the renewed permit effective April 30, 2012.





2. The terms and conditions of the existing permit are being satisfactorily met (R645-303-233.110).
3. The present underground coal mining activities are in compliance with the environmental protection standards of the Act and the Utah State Program (R645-303-233.120).
4. The requested renewal will not substantially jeopardize the operator's continuing ability to comply with the Act and the Utah State Program (R645-303-233.130).
5. The permittee has provided evidence of having liability insurance (National Union Fire Ins Co Pittsburgh PA GL093-61-11)(R645-303-233.140).
6. The permittee has posted a reclamation surety in the required amount and has provided evidence that the surety will remain in full effect for the additional permit period (Surety issued by Agronaut Insurance Company, #SUR0000311, in the amount of \$5,137,000. (R645-303-233.150)).




