2. Signs and Markers

The identification sign contain the same information as in Chapter 1 in the Mining and Reclamation Plan. The Identification sign meets the requirements in the R645 Coal Rules.

3. Topsoil

I did not see any signs of wind or water erosion on the topsoil stockpile.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The diversions and culverts were open. No water was flowing in the diversions during the inspection.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The mine site sediment pond was discharging. This pond discharges nearly constantly. No other sediment pond was discharging during the inspection. There was wood on the embankment of the loadout sediment pond. This was removed by the permittee. I did not see any hazardous conditions to the sediment pond.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The refuse pile was inspected. I did not see any hazardous conditions. Although the refuse pile is being mined it was inactive during the inspection.

8. Noncoal Waste

The site was clean of non-coal waste materials.

16.b Roads: Drainage Controls

I inspected road drainage throughout the property. The diversions and culverts were open and functioning as design.
