1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale

Skyline has several amendments submitted to the Division at the present time. These are the Skyline Flat Canyon Lease Amendment, Skyline Swens Canyon Ventilation Facilities and the Skyline NOG Bleeder Shafts. The latter one the Division is waiting for a response from the Division.

2. Signs and Markers

I inspected the identifications signs meet the requirements R645 Coal Rules.

3. Topsoil

The topsoil piles were protected from wind and water erosion by having vegetative ground cover. The permittee will be receiving some additional soil from the White Oak Project this year. The permittee will use this soil for reclamation projects in the future. This material is projected to be stored at the waste rock site.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

Several of the diversions and culverts were inspected. They were functioning as design. A diversion at the upper pad area needed removal of some sediment. The permittee remove the sediment from the diversion. See pictures.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

I inspected the sediment ponds and did not see any hazardous conditions. The ponds appear to be stable. The mine and loadout ponds contained water. The embankment inlets, outlets were stable.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The waste rock site was inspected. I did not see any hazardous conditions. It appears that the site was not used this summer. No refuse was added or removed. The slopes are irregular at the present time. Material/refuse was removed and ship to a cleaning facilities. These slopes and refuse pile in general need to meet the designs in the MPR. I am working with the permittee about having the slopes and the refuse pile meeting the designs in the MRP.

8. Noncoal Waste

The mine site was clear of non-coal waste materials.

10. Slides and Other Damage

No slides or other damage was noticed during the inspection.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

Roads are well maintain and have been recently graveled.
