During our meeting you mentioned forwarding to us some information we discussed at the meeting, including:

1. Transducer data from the JC series wells;
2. The major hydrologic investigation of the Burnout Canyon drainage by Canyon Fuel Company in 1991; and,
3. CFCs responses to the Aley report (August 25, 2005) indicate that blind samples obtained by CFC from JC-1 and analyzed by Ozark Underground Laboratory show no detections of fluorescein or eosine. There is no mention of these samples in his (Aley) report or in other reports. Do you have a report that shows the results of the blind sample test results that CFC refers to?
