The above-referenced Minor Exploration Notice of Intent has been reviewed as of September 25, 2017. You have addressed all the requirements of the Minor Coal exploration rules in the R645 Coal Rules. The Notice of Intent indicates that less than 5 acres will be disturbed and less than 250 tons of coal will be extracted. Please have a copy of the Notice of Intent at the exploration site upon inspection.

The Division is requesting upon final installation/completion of the Seismic Station on Boulger Reservoir Dam, two (2) pictures from different angles to be submitted to the Division in Salt Lake City and Stephen J. Demczak at the PFO.

It is recommended that the following information will be needed prior to exploration and available to an onsite inspection.

- a) The applicant must receive landowner consent and a cultural/archaeology approval from the United States Forest Service.
- b) Provide to the Division an approval from Dam Safety for Seismic Station installation.
