Hi Arati,

Just a quick follow up to your email. For clarity, the four (4) flow measurements that were submitted **were** the manual measurements recorded when collecting the UPDES samples on that day (which complies to the UPDES permit). Concerning the continuous monitoring of the discharge, the software (RS-link) is set up to retrieve the previous month's data. Some electrical problems occurred at the Mine in early February which prohibited the January download. We believe the daily data for January has been recorded, but that some minor programming needs to be done to retrieve data further back than the previous month. Mine personnel have been consumed with a longwall move for the last several weeks, but we hope to modify the program to retrieve additional daily flow averages on Monday.

Let me know if you have any questions. We'll keep you posted on what we determine.
