A. CLEAN-UP

- 1-3. Since some facilities will have salvage value, an estimate of \$500. was chosen to remove unusable debris.

B. REGRADING & RECONTOURING

1. Refuse piles will have side slopes less than 27 degrees (MESA specification) during active life, no regrading needed.
2. Not applicable
3. Soil will be spread at 6" depth overaall reject piles for a total of 36 acres and 29,040 cubic yards. One dollar (\$1.00) is the most recent figure available from the D.O.T. on hauling  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile or less, and spreading soil.

C. STABILIZATION

1. Fertilization costs \$12.00 per acre over the 59.7 acres of reject piles, general operations area, and landfill. This includes cuts fills, pads, and stockpile.
2. Seeding at an average of \$100./acre (from Utah contractor) for 59.7 acres.
3. Miscellaneous waterbars, or drainage ditches estimated to cost \$200.
