Mr. Steve Rigby of Plateau Mining Company's Star Point Mine was visited on May 2, 1979, by Mike Thompson and Jim Smith to discuss the information required of Plateau Mining to abate the violations issued by the Division in a letter dated January 31, 1979. The deadline established for submitting the information was April 6, 1979. On March 8, 1979, a meeting was held with Plateau Mining representatives and Division personnel. During this meeting it was established that two (2) of the ten (10) violations issued, Violation Numbers 3 and 10, presented a problem to Plateau and subsequently resulted in a request for a hearing with the Board. The other eight violations could be brought into compliance by the deadline. However, this information was not received by the Division. Upon talking with Mr. Rigby, it was his feeling that all the information would be submitted at the time of the hearing. He was informed that only two of the violations were to be presented to the Board and the rest of the violations were to have been submitted to the Division by April 6, 1979. He responded that he would have the required information to the Division this week.

Plateau is in the process of trying to reschedule the hearing from May until June, due to Mr. Bailey having to be in Washington, D.C. during the May hearing.
