Dear Mr. Crane:

Plateau Mining Company accepts the conditions and stipulations attached to the above captioned lease as set forth in your letter of October 31, 1980 with the following understandings as discussed between Mr. John Nadolski of your office and Mr. Steve Rigby of this operation on November 4, 1980:

1. UNC will be changed to PMC (PMC denotes Plateau Mining Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of Getty Minerals Company, which is in turn a wholly owned subsidiary of the Getty Oil Company).
2. PMC will provide O.S.M. and the D.O.G.M. of Utah with its proposed "Subsidence Monitoring Plan" as it is to be included in our revised, comprehensive mining and reclamation plan. This will provide the various agencies the opportunity to review the method of subsidence monumentation in Section 6 so that there is no question as to the subsidence network control over this portion of the mine.
3. PMC is authorized to proceed through the shaded areas as indicated on the map submitted to you for approval October 10, 1980. This authorization is valid as long as minable coal is present beyond the projected burn line, the development schedule and plan is followed as outlined in the October 10, 1980 proposal, the U.S.G.S. concurs with our mining procedure, and that no more than 250,000 tons are mined from this lease

prior to November 1, 1981.

As indicated in the telephone conversation, a letter will be forthcoming from O.S.M. to P.M.C. with these clarifications outlined. We do not anticipate there will be any discrepancies between our understanding and the clarifications as contained in this letter.
