SUBJECT: Star Point Mines and Pinnacle/Apex Mining and Reclamation Plan  
 Review - Trip Report

On August 25th, Jodie Merriman and I met with the staff on the Utah Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining (DOGM) in order to coordinate the mining and reclamation plan of the above two mines. Both reviews are in the technical analysis stage of the permitting process. OSM has already completed a draft of the technical and environmental analysis (TEA) for the Star Point Mines. This draft was given to DOGM at the meeting.

It was agreed upon that OSM would continue to provide assistance to DOGM for the Star Point TEA. This will be in the form of sending staff to Salt Lake City office in order to help put together the decision document (Jodie Merriman and myself for up to seven days each). In the meantime, DOGM staff will finalize the TEA.

In regard to the Pinnacle/Apex review, DOGM will prepare the technical analysis and OSM will prepare the environmental assessment.

It was also decided that OSM would do the review for the mini-ACR (response to the initial apparent completeness review) for Eureka Energy's Sage Point-Dugout Canyon Mine.
