The time for abatement may be extended by the authorized representative for good cause, if a request is made within a reasonable time before the end of the abatement period.

Failure to file a notice of intention to explore.

Provision(s) of the Regulations, Act, or Permit Violated

UMC 815.11(a)

Exploration activity in the Winter Quarters Canyon vicinity.

Remedial Action Required (including interim steps, if any)

File a written notice of intention to explore with the Division prior to continuing exploration activities. The notice should be adequate and address all requirements of UMC 776.11(a) and UMC 815.11(a).

Time for Abatement (including time for interim steps, if any)

Immediately. No later than August 21, 1981.

Nature of the Violation

Failure to prevent erosion and additional contributions of suspended solids to streamflow or runoff outside the exploration area.

Provision(s) of the Regulations, Act, or Permit Violated

UMC 815.15 (c)(3)

Portion of the Operation to which Notice Applies

Exploration activity on the Winter Quarters Canyon access road.

Remedial Action Required (including interim steps, if any)

Implement drainage control measures to divert undisturbed area runoff away from the exploration disturbance and retain ^{or treat} runoff from the disturbed area so as to prevent erosion and contributions of suspended solids to streamflow and runoff outside the ~~for~~ exploration area.

Time for Abatement (including time for interim steps, if any)

Immediately. No later than August 21, 1981.

Nature of the Violation

Failure to remove and store topsoil for redistribution on disturbed areas.

Provision(s) of the Regulations, Act, or Permit Violated

UMC 815.15(e)

Portion of the Operation to which Notice Applies

Exploration activity on the Winter Quarters Canyon access road.

Remedial Action Required (including interim steps, if any)

Remove topsoil prior to disturbance. Store topsoil in a manner allowing for redistribution on the disturbed area assuring successful revegetation (ie protect topsoil from loss due to water erosion or contamination, thereby retaining a good revegetation potential)

Time for Abatement (including time for interim steps, if any)

Immediately, no later than August 21, 1981.
