We are in receipt of the report entitled "Survey for Cliff Nesting Falcons and Golden Eagles, Star Point Mines" prepared by the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources.

In order to evaluate whether mining activities will impact on the active aeries located in this survey, we need a map that delineates the actual area surveyed for raptor nests, areas of existing or proposed mine disturbance, and the exact locations of the aeries that were discovered. We will consider the report complete when we receive this information. Also, it is still necessary for Plateau Mining Company to assess other avifauna of high federal interest on the Star Point Mine for areas of new disturbance.
