

Dear Dave:

This letter is to confirm our phone conversation of November 19, 1982.

With receipt of funding for reclamation of Drill Hole 81-5-1P we began to mobilize to complete reclamation in the allotted time. With the recommendations of the cat operator (Jack Otani) and our on-site personnel, reclamation proved inopportune. Snow accumulations and anticipated snow fall caused the site to be inaccessible. Further access to the site would subsequently damage the site diminishing the benefit of fall reclamation.

With the coming of spring, reclamation will be undertaken in a responsible and expeditious manner.

You mentioned modification of the violation to accomodate the inaccessability of the site and allow reclamation in the spring of 1983. I would appreciate your written recommendations and comments on this matter for our files.
