The Utah Preservation Office has received your letter of October 15, 1982, transmitting a copy of Plateau Mining Company's permit application for a breakout modification in Corner Canyon, Carbon County, Utah.

After review of the information provided, and a conversation with Oil, Gas & Mining staff, our office has been informed and has noted in the report that a cultural resource management survey has been requested by Plateau Mining Company on the approximate five acres that have been designated for the breakout. Considering this information, our office feels that the material provided is adequate to submit to the Office of Surface Mining and believes that this survey, if conducted in proper manner as usually carried out by the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining and Plateau Mining Company, will be of a satisfactory nature to meet any stipulations that might be applied in this breakout area.
